

CHILDPROOFING 2.0 TIPS FOR THE MODERN HOME

You've probably heard of these tips...

COVER OUTLETS with safety plugs or plastic covers







2 LOCK CABINETS that contain cleaning products, especially if they're at floor-level



3 KEEP SHARP OBJECTS, such as scissors and knives, out of sight and OUT OF REACH



5 PLACE SAFETY GATES at the top and bottom of the stairs





Don't forget the laundry room
